Respite:

- Weekday Respite:
 - For parents and carers
 - Respite centres located in Wollongong, Shellharbour, Kiama and Nowra with programs delivered Monday-Friday 9am-4pm
- Weekend Respite:
 - Weekend Respite centres located in Kemira at IRT
 William Beach Gardens in Kanahooka and Ord Place in Albion Park,
 - Respite is also offered at Greenacre Road centre 7 days a week, and though there is no overnight option at the centre, overnight-in-home respite can be arranged through this service
- In-home Respite:
 - Flexible in home support through Greenacres Respite
 Options service, one to one respite support is also offered

Age Friendly Services:

- Greenacres Retirement Options:
 - A centre based day program that allows participants to transition from supported employment to retirement

Individual Support:

- Individual Supported Options:
 - For school leavers who feel they are not ready to go straight into the workforce
 - Specifically for people with moderate to very high support needs, especially those with a primary physical disability
 - Assistance with transport, job training, independent living, etc.
 - Independent Living Skills:
 - Green acres can support people to learn skills that the need such as; travel training, shopping, budgeting, laundry, cleaning, gardening, etc.
