## Services:

- Provides free legal advice and referrals to women in NSW, particularly those who are socially and economically disadvantaged
- Provides legal advice in areas such as; family law; domestic and family violence; sexual assault; victim support; human rights and access to justice issues; care and protection; and discrimination and employment

#### **Specialist Programs:**

- Domestic Violence Legal Service: free legal service for a range of areas including; casework; legal advice and advocacy
- Indigenous Women's Legal Program: staffed by women and offers free services including; free legal advice via the Indigenous Women's Legal Contact Line, assistance in finding a lawyer and face-to-face advice through IWLP Outreach Clinics
- Working Women's Legal service: provides free legal advice via the Working Women's Legal Service if someone has experienced sexual harassment, pregnancy discrimination or discrimination because of family responsibilities
